Why Cagliari?

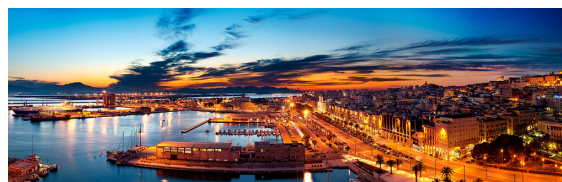

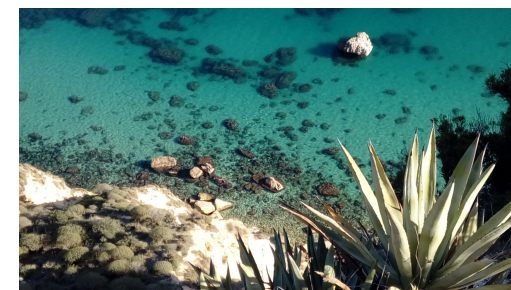

How to get to Cagliari

Cagliari is accessible by plane or by boat. Find out the best solution for you!



The city airport Cagliari-Elmas is connected via plane with many major European cities such as London, Paris, Berlin, Barcelona, Krakow and Bratislava among others. The airport is 8 km far from the city centre and connected by train or buses.

The harbour is right in the city centre. One of the most enchanting views of the city is offered to visitors arriving by sea. You can admire the harbour, the castle walls and the impressive towers of San Pancrazio and L'Elefante, which date back to 1305.
