LEARNING OUTCOMES AND RESEARCH TOPICS	<p>In relation to the high diversification of the professional outlets, the PhD program provides, in addition to a common training course, a significant number of additional activities to be agreed with the individual doctoral student depending on the scientific and professional options that each will be developed in the three years and that will find their main expression in the choice of the thesis. As for the common training, it aims to develop in the doctoral student a high critical awareness of the complexity of the legal phenomenon in all its many aspects, to provide him, in other words, what, with effective metaphor, have been called the glasses of the jurist. Obviously, the common training will take on greater importance during the first year, but it will continue to constitute the backbone of the activity in the following years, in which all doctoral students will be called upon to compare their respective experiences. As far as the thesis is concerned, the objective to be achieved is that of reaching a result from which it emerges that the candidate is in possession of a methodological and conceptual toolkit suitable for carrying out scientific research and has reached a critical capacity that allows him/her not only to deal with the necessary in-depth analysis of the problems arising from the topic addressed, but also to deal with them with the mature autonomy of judgment that allows to reach innovative results.</p> <p>With the support of the Centro Linguistico di Ateneo, doctoral candidates will also acquire the B2-CEFR level of linguistic competence in one of the four fundamental languages of the EU (English, French, Spanish, German and Italian for foreign doctoral candidates).</p> <p>The improvement of doctoral students in computer science is functional to the specific research activity in law. To this end, on the one hand the supervisors of doctoral candidates will take care of transmitting their knowledge on the subject, and on the other hand the doctoral candidates will be admitted to attend the lessons of the course of Legal Informatics and methodology of research of sources activated at the School of Specialization for Legal Professions of the University. During the PhD, finally, if they have achieved scientifically relevant results, we will promote their publication in the series of the</p>



	<p>Department or in other scientific journals. It will also promote the participation of doctoral students as speakers at conferences on topics covered by their research. At the end of the doctoral course is finally expected the possibility to publish online or in paper form the entire doctoral thesis or part of it.</p>

The project will be evaluated during the interview exclusively and must include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> i) purpose of the proposed research project and the related curriculum; ii) state of the art of research; iii) detailed workplan; iv) expected results; v) motivation letter, i.e. max. 1,000 characters (including spaces) explaining the reasons prompting the candidate to apply for the PhD Programme. <p>With regard to linguistic skills, in the event of failure to produce certificates attesting the achievement of a level of knowledge B1 or higher, the basic knowledge of a language chosen from English, French, Spanish and German will be ascertained during the interview, to assess that the candidate’s level allows him/her to understand legal texts in that language without the aid of a vocabulary.</p>
