 Plan of the site



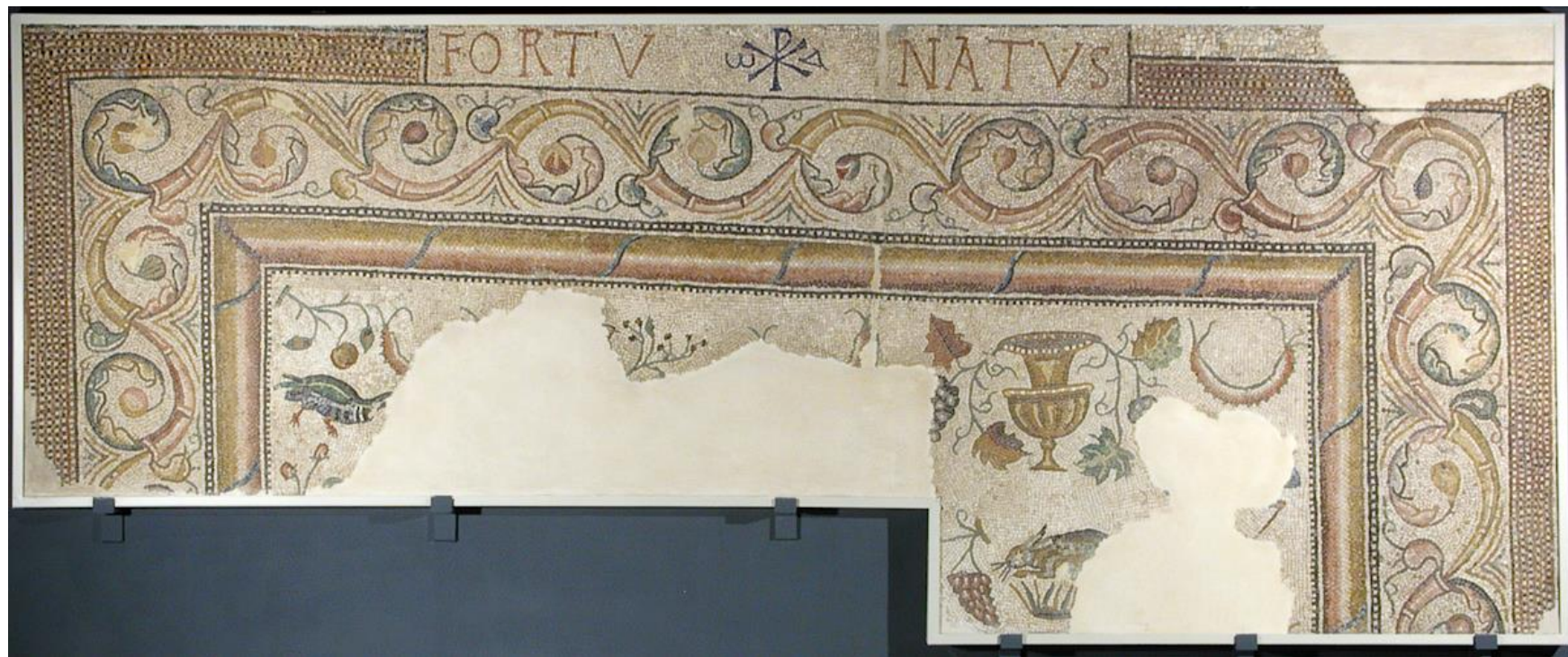


















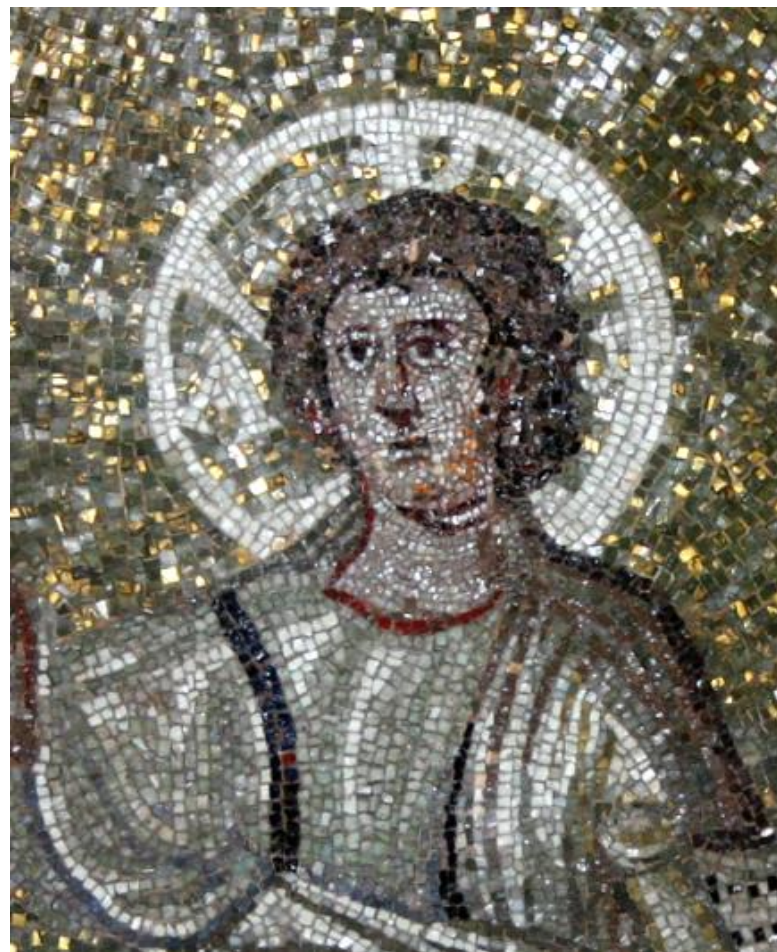












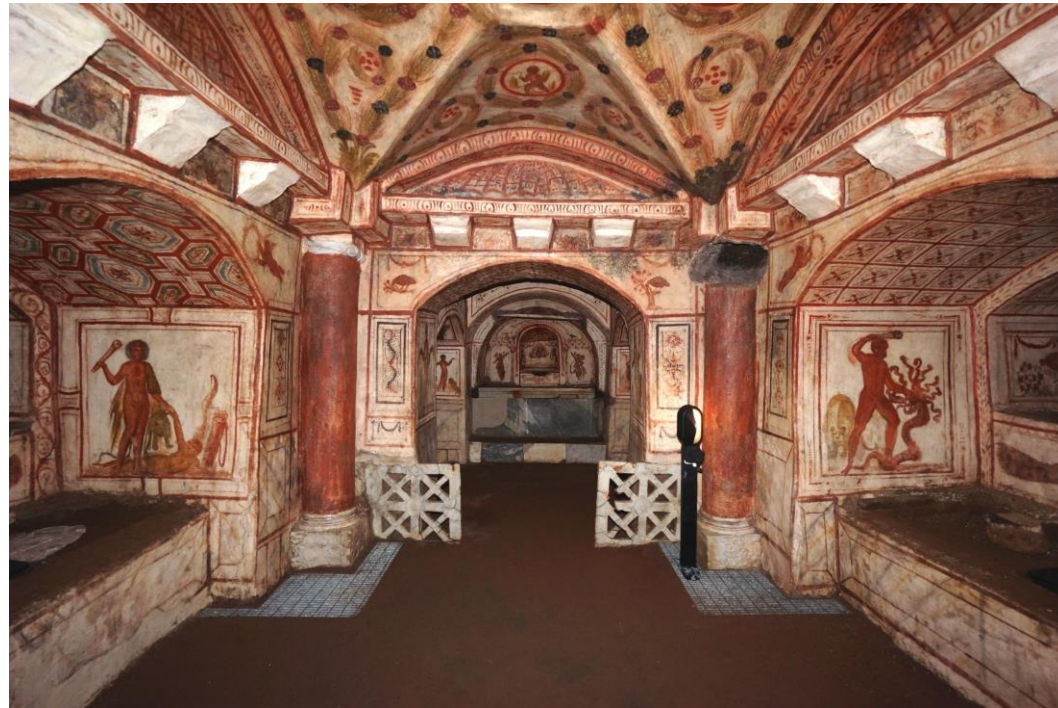
















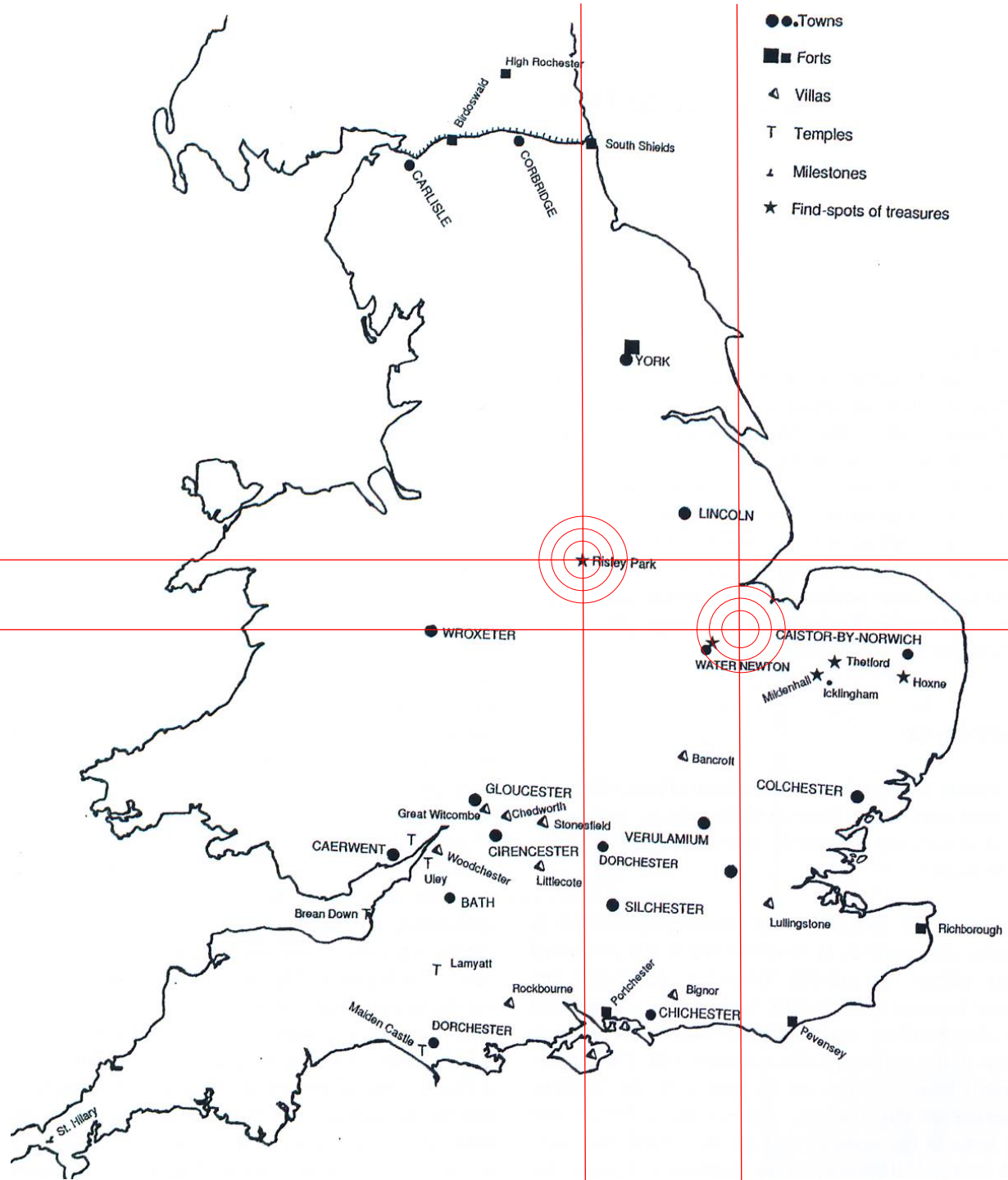




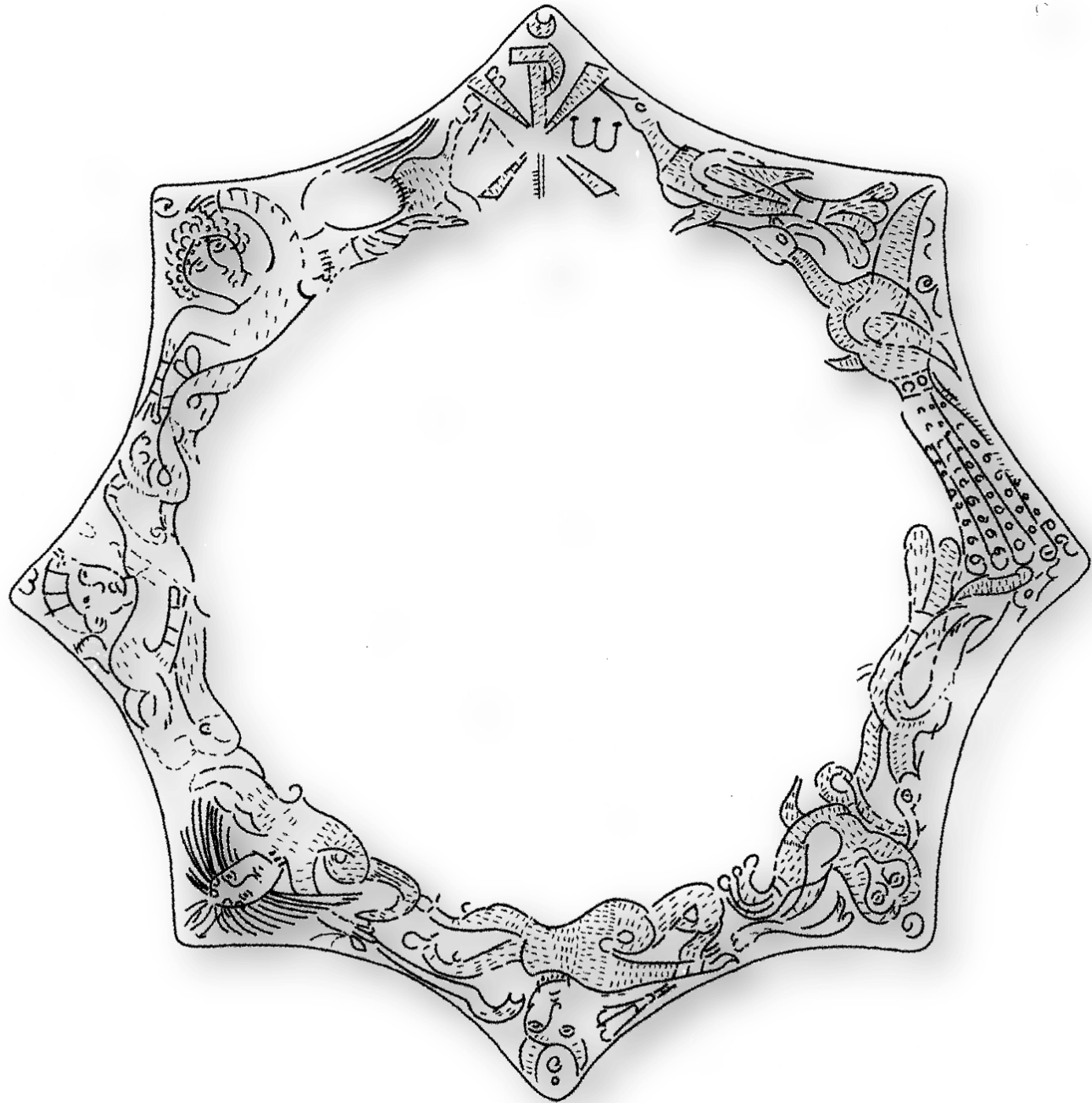
