Currently I am a Post-Doctoral Research Fellow (RTD-A) in International Law at the Department of Social and Political Science of the University of Cagliari, a reporter for ORIL-IHRL (OPIL - OUP) and a member of the editorial committee of two peer-reviewed journals. UNHCR appointed me as Independent Expert on International Protection and Human Rights, and I was official appointed as a member of the Territorial Commission for the recognition of International Protection of Cagliari by Decree of the Minister of Internal Affairs.

I obtained my Law Degree (2017) and my PhD (2021) at the University of Napoli Federico II - Law Department. I was a Postdoctoral Research Fellow in International Law at the CNR-IRISS, Napoli (2021). My current research interests include international and EU migration law and international protection of human rights, with a focus on socioeconomic rights in contexts of crisis.
