

## **Innovative teaching**

**WHAT ARE FUNDS FOR INNOVATIVE TEACHING?** Funds for innovative teaching are funds from the Departmental Project of Excellence budget. They are allocated to financing educational projects for students and their aim is to supplement traditional teaching with initiatives based on practical methodologies and/or direct experience (e.g. legal clinics, trial simulations, visits to national and international institutions, etc.). These projects must therefore have an exclusively educational content and must award University Credits.

**WHO CAN APPLY?** The Department's academic staff are entitled to access the funds.

**PROCEDURE TO BE FOLLOWED** Projects must be submitted using the appropriate form. It must be fully completed, otherwise the application will be excluded from the process. The individual items of expenditure relating to the amount of funding requested must be specified. Applicants are advised to submit projects with moderate, rational and effective use of funds. The form may be sent at any time to the Head of the Department, who will assess a) the eligibility of the applications and b) the appropriateness of the funding requested. Applications regarding solely seminar and conference activities will not be accepted. The maximum expenditure limit for each project will be Euro 5,000. A reasoned request may be sent to the Head of the Department to exceed the limit by 35%.
