Description	<p><u>How to conduct a GDPR Compliance Project</u></p> <p>Instructor: Bence Kis Kelemen Dr.</p> <p>Overview: The purpose of the course is to introduce students to the steps, methodology, obstacles and possible outcomes of a GDPR compliance projects. Big law firms and even smaller ones regularly conduct GDPR compliance projects for clients of different sizes. It is essential for students, who wish to work in this field of law and this field of the legal profession to get an insight even during their university years on how to participate effectively in such a project.</p> <p>Content: The course will cover a full GDPR compliance project. The course will teach students how to identify the scope for a project based on the needs of the client and the risk</p>

assessment previously conducted. The course will also outline a basic timeline for the different tasks in a compliance project, teach the different tasks in the project, and help students learn to create templates for Privacy Policies and other basic GDPR compliance documents. The course is practice-oriented and not connected to any one of the Member States of the EU, but deal with GDPR obligations applicable to all data controllers and processors operating the EU.

Impact: The impact of the project is that students will be more confident in applying for jobs in Big4 Law firms and bigger national law firms since they will have hands-on experience on how to conduct a very important task that will be a possible part of their future jobs.

Learning objectives: The students after completing the course will be able to

1. identify the scope of a GDPR compliance project
2. set a timeline for a differently scoped GDPR compliance projects
3. identify and explain the different segments of a GDPR compliance project
4. conduct the initial risk assessment connected to the project
5. set up and analyze a request for an information platform/table
6. identify the obstacles in the GDPR compliance project
7. draft basic GDPR compliance documents (Privacy Policy, Legitimate Interest Test, Consent form etc.)
