AMENDMENT TO THE REGULATIONS FOR GRANTING AUTHORISATION TO TEACH OFF-SITE

THE RECTOR,

HAVING REGARD TO the current Statute of the University of Cagliari, issued by Rectoral Decree no. 305 of 28.03.2022, published in the Official Gazette - general series - no. 88 of 24 April 2022;

HAVING REGARD TO Law no. 311 of 18.03.1958, in particular art. 6, para. (11);

HAVING REGARD TO Presidential Decree no. 382 of 11.07.1980, and in particular art. 114, para. (1);

HAVING REGARD TO Law no. 240 of 30.12.2010, in particular art. 6, para. (11);

HAVING REGARD TO Rectoral Decree No. 480 of 7 June 2010 on the issuance of the *Regulation for the granting of authorisation to teach off-site*;

HAVING REGARD TO the resolutions of the Academic Senate and the Board of Directors concerning the recommended amendments to the *Regulation for the granting of authorisation to teach off-site*, dated 26 and 31 January 2023, respectively;

CONSIDERING also the need to issue the *Regulation for the granting of authorisation to teach off-site*

ISSUES THE FOLLOWING D E C R E E

- ART. 1 - The "*Regulations for the granting of authorisation to teach off-site*" are hereby issued, amended as set out in the annex which forms an integral part of this decree.
- ART. 2 - The Rules and Regulations shall be published on the University website and shall come into force as of the day following the date of publication.

Regulations for the granting of authorization to teach off-site

Art. 1

1. Professors and researchers of the University of Cagliari, in the absence of specific agreements with other universities as provided for by art. 6, paragraph 11 of law no. 240/2010, may only accept teaching posts in degree courses at other universities after the Rector has issued the *nulla osta*, following the positive recommendation of the relevant department.
2. For teaching assignments in specialisation courses, level I and II Master's courses and research doctorates, the authorisation of the department to which the lecturer belongs is sufficient.

Art. 2

1. In order to be granted authorisation, professors and researchers must send their application for authorisation to the Director of the department to which they belong and to the Personnel, Organisation and Performance Directorate at least 30 days before taking up their appointment.
2. The Departmental Council, after verifying the applicant's teaching load and the teaching coverage plan in the applicant's academic discipline, after verifying the applicant's scientific/academic achievements, commitment to teaching and organisational activities, and participation in the activities of collegial bodies, and after verifying the positive evaluation of the applicant's teaching at the University by students, shall decide on the application and forward it to the Personnel, Organisation and Performance Directorate.

Art. 3

1. The Personnel, Organisation and Performance Directorate, having verified the regularity of the procedure, will examine the dossier to be submitted to the Rector, who, taking into account the opinion of the department, will grant the authorisation by means of a decree, which will be immediately forwarded by the department itself to the University and to the professor or researcher concerned.

Art. 4

1. The Personnel, Organisation and Performance Directorate shall inform the Academic Senate every six months of all authorisations issued by the Rector.
