## PROFILE

Laura Candiotta is **Associate Professor of Moral Philosophy at the University of Cagliari**, Department of Pedagogy, Psychology, Philosophy, **Italy** and at the **University of Pardubice**, Department of Philosophy and Religious Studies, **Czech Republic**. She is a member of the **Centre for Ethics**. She specialises in **philosophy of emotion**, at the crisscross of **social epistemology** and **ethics**, with a key focus on situated approaches to caring and affectivity in transforming environments (**AI ethics; environmental ethics**)

Her **research** is focused on the epistemic and moral role of emotions, especially as embedded in **dialogical interactions** and **cultures**. In the last five years, she has reached a leading position in the **epistemology of emotion research**, especially with her work on **4Ecognition (embodied, embedded, enactive, and extended cognition)**.

She is currently the **Principal Investigator of "VEC: Vicious Epistemic Cultures"**, a project on **Vice Epistemology and the Ethics of Knowledge** funded by the Czech Science Foundation (GACR) and of **"RAISE: Research and development of tools for detecting and mitigating epistemic injustice in AI systems for identifying misleading information"**, a project on the **Ethics of AI**, funded by the Czech Technological Foundation (TACR). She leads the Faculty of Arts Excellent Research Team **"Loving is Caring: Towards a Platonic Care Ethics"** at the University of Pardubice. She is also a team member of "Beyond Security" (Operational Programme Research), working on values, emotions and technology in the Anthropocene. She is developing an **enactive ethics approach to environmental love, grief, and hope**.

She is a member of **Mind and Life Europe**, where she serves as a member of the ARC Committee (before that she was the chair of the ESRI Planning Committee). In 2024 she was the Humanities Mind and Life Representative at ISCR "Embodied Cognition and Intersubjectivity in Uncertain Times". She was a Fellow of the **4<sup>th</sup> Intercontinental Academy on "Intelligence and Artificial Intelligence"** (Working on the Ethics of AI) by the University-based Institutes of Advanced Studies (UBIAS) (2021-2023); **Alexander von Humboldt Senior Research Fellow** at the **Free University of Berlin** (2019-2021); **Marie Skłodowska-Curie Research Fellow** at the **University of Edinburgh**, Eidyn Research Centre (2016-2018); researcher at the **IMÈRA Institute for Advance Study** of the **Aix-Marseille University** (2018-2019); visiting professor at the **University of Modena and Reggio Emilia** (2023), **Mind & Life Institute** (2017, 2021), **Fudan University** of Shanghai (2017), and the **Pontifical University of Curitiba**, Brazil (2016); postdoctoral fellow at **Ca' Foscari University of Venice** (2013-2015).

She received her PhD in philosophy in 2011 at **Ca' Foscari University of Venice** (in partnership with **CNRS and Paris-Sorbonne**). She holds a post-graduate specialization in Philosophy for Children and Community (**University of Padua**, 2006). She holds the **Associate Professor Habilitation in Theoretical Philosophy** since 2018, in **Aesthetics and Philosophy of Language** since 2023, and in **Moral Philosophy** since 2025.

She is a review editor for **Frontiers in Psychology** (Theoretical and Philosophical Psychology) and the book review editor for the **Plato Journal**. She has delivered **more than 80 talks** at **international conferences and workshops**.

She was nominated for the “**Best Overall Teacher**” **Award** by the **University of Edinburgh Students' Association** (2017). She received the **Rector's Award in recognition of outstanding contribution to the field of ethics of care** in 2025 (University of Pardubice).
