ART. 1 - PROFESSIONAL MASTER'S PROGRAMME IN CLINICAL AND SURGICAL ENDODONTICS

For the academic year 2019/2020 the University of Cagliari (UniCa) announces a public selection for the admission to the 2nd level Professional Master's Programme in **CLINICAL AND SURGICAL ENDODONTICS** (Duration: 10 months; Credits: 60).

ART. 2 - DEPARTMENT IN CHARGE OF THE PROGRAMME

The Department in charge of the Programme is at the Department of Surgical Science.

ART. 3 - EDUCATIONAL OBJECTIVES

The professions included in the dental unit conduct research on theories and methods, i.e. apply existing knowledge in the field of diagnosis, treatment of pathologies, injuries and malformations of the dental arches and other structures of the oral cavity; treat dysfunctions of dental occlusions, pathologies of nerve structures and dental tissues.

Therefore, the main objective of the course is to train in endodontic and restorative dental care, at a high level and according to current quality standards, professionals operating in the dental field, both public and private. The master's degree aims to provide dental professionals with the tools necessary to deepen their knowledge in the field of clinical and surgical endodontic therapy and restorative management of the simple and complex cases, including the "single implant tooth" in all cases where the tooth cannot be saved.

At present, there is increased interest from the world health community in safeguarding the health of the oral cavity and, in particular, the dental structures attached to it (World Health Report, WHO: 2003; Healthy People 2010-Oral Health). The WHO report published in 2003 underlines the importance of good oral and therefore dental health in maintaining an optimal state of systemic condition of the individual and consequently his quality of life, in economic, social and psychological terms. The prevention of diseases is encouraged not only through the development of strategies that prevent the onset of diseases (Primary Prevention), but also in the implementation of appropriate therapeutic protocols when the presence of diseases is assessed (Secondary and tertiary prevention). The anatomic-functional restoration of dental elements affected by carious lesions and/or traumatic pathologies require therapeutic interventions, to eliminate the pathogens capable of involving not only the dental structures but also their periradicular bone. Endodontics is a part of Restorative Dentistry aimed at obtaining the ordinary or even extreme recovery of damaged dental elements. It represents the routine in conservative therapy of elements suffering from carious lesions and, at the same time, the extreme care that allows the recovery of the radicular portion of a compromised tooth, postponing or avoiding the loss of the same. Clinical and surgical endodontic treatment, in addition to safeguarding infected dental elements, is crucial in preventing and/or reducing the chances of the spread of noxa patogena in neighboring bone districts (with the appearance of apex granulomas, cysts, osteomyelitis), and for

systemic bacteriemia, favoring the onset of pathological disorders in other districts of the body. Therefore, endodontic and restorative restoration with the consequent anatomical-functional reinstatement of compromised dental organs can have important socio-economic implications concerning public health aspects. This would result in a reduction in the costs that the private citizen would face in cases of partial and total edentulism, resulting from the loss of one or more dental elements, establishing a favorable cost-benefit ratio. In addition, it should be stressed that at present there is a greater demand for endodontic treatments in systemically compromised patients, undergoing various drug therapies and for whom more attention and review of treatment protocols with specific guidelines are needed.

ART. 4 - ORGANIZATION OF THE PROGRAMME

The training programme is divided into:

- 128 hours of classroom lessons (16 credits);
- 500 hours of clinical internship at the Dental Restoration and Endodontics Unit of the University Hospital of Cagliari (20 credits);
- 72 hours for the final examination (9 credit);
- 375 hours of research activities (15 CFU);
- 425 hours of self-study.

The activities will take place at the Dental Restoration Unit of the University Hospital and in the classrooms of the University Campus in Monserrato, for 20 days per month, 5 days a week (25 hours a week).

ART. 5 - AVAILABLE POSITIONS

The programme is open to a maximum of 13 students.
The programme will start only if at least 5 students are admitted.

ART. 6 - ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR SELECTION

The Admission to the Programme is open to graduates, regardless of nationality, holding (ref. to the [Italian university system](#)):

- a degree awarded according to Italian Ministerial Decree no. 270/2004 (*laurea magistrale*) or
- a degree awarded according to Italian Ministerial Decree no. 509/1999 (*laurea specialistica*) in Dentistry
- a degree awarded according to Italian Ministerial Decree no. 270/2004 (*laurea magistrale*) in Medicine and Surgery and a postgraduate specialization in Odontostomatology

The admission is also open to candidates holding an academic qualification (2nd cycle university degree: Master-level) issued by a foreign university recognized as equivalent.

The foreign university degree must be evaluated suitable and equivalent, in terms of duration, level of degree and fields of study to the degree listed above.

The Examination Board will deliberate on equivalence, in compliance with the current legislation in Italy and in the Country where it was issued, and with international treaties or agreements concerning the recognition of qualifications for further studies for the sole purpose of admission to the 2nd level Professional Master’s Programme.

Admission is also open to students who are going to graduate not later than the selection date. These candidates will be admitted with reservation and will submit a certificate (only for degrees obtained

abroad) or a self-declaration of their graduation together with a copy of a valid ID. The certificate/self-declaration can be sent to dottoratiemaster@unica.it, or delivered by hand.

If the applicant is evaluated positively to be admitted to the 2nd level Professional Master's Programme but he/she will not be awarded the necessary degree by the above-mentioned date, he/she will lose that suitable position.

ART. 7 - HOW TO APPLY

To participate in the selection, candidates can apply through the online procedure available on the webpage 'Servizi Online' of UniCa website at <https://webstudenti.unica.it/esse3/Start.do> **from the date of the publication of the present Notice of Competition to 15th November 2019 at 12:00 p.m. (local time).**

In the event that, close to the deadline, the number of candidates will be lower than 15, the deadline will be postponed automatically. The new deadline will be published on UniCa website at: https://www.unica.it/unica/it/studenti_s01_ss06.page (News and Deadlines).

According to Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, art. 46, applicants must provide the following information for the online procedure:

- a) name and surname, Italian tax identification code (*codice fiscale*) – for candidates applying for the first time, place and date of birth, residence address, telephone number, e-mail and current address where correspondence related to the selection can be sent;
- b) citizenship;
- c) exact name of the professional master's programme selected;
- d) name of University degree, date of graduation, final grade, name of the issuing University;
- e) to possess the eligibility requirements reported in the call for applications and to be aware of the text of the call;
- f) to be aware of being subject to penalty if any information provided is later found to be untrue according to Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, art. 76;
- g) to have read [notice](#) no. 2016/679 issued according to EU Regulations and the Italian Law in force, about the protection of people regarding the treatment of personal data, as well as on the free circulation of data;
- h) to give the consent to communicate and disseminate his/her own personal data for the purposes of the present Professional Master's Call.

According to art. 20 of Italian Law no. 104/92, applicants with disabilities must specify in their application the required assistance for their needs, including possible requests for additional time for the completion of the tests, by sending an e-mail to the PhD and Professional Master Office, which could involve SIA - UniCa Office for Disability.

The sensitive data reported for this purpose will be kept secret and processed in accordance with the provisions currently in force.

ITALIAN APPLICANTS HOLDING A UNIVERSITY DEGREE ISSUED IN ITALY OR ABROAD AND FOREIGN APPLICANTS HOLDING AN ITALIAN UNIVERSITY DEGREE

Italian and foreign applicants holding a degree issued in Italy, at the end of the online compiling procedure, will have to upload the following documents in PDF format (each file not exceeding 1 MB):

degree (note that CERTIFICATES RELATED TO THE DEGREE CANNOT BE ATTACHED; YOU CAN ONLY ATTACH SELF-DECLARATIONS OR REPLACEMENT (SELF)DECLARATIONS FOR CERTIFICATIONS). Applicants holding a degree issued by the University of Cagliari can download their replacement declaration for certifications from their personal webpage, in the reserved area of the online Students' services at <https://webstudenti.unica.it/esse3/Start.do>: "*Autodichiarazione Conseguimento Titolo con Esam?*";

- two-sided coloured copy of a valid ID, with a clear photo;

According to art. 40 of Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000, public bodies can no longer receive or request from private citizens certificates issued by other public institutions. Therefore, all qualifications must be provided only through a self-declaration of certifications or a self-declaration affidavit, according to articles 46 and 47 of Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000. Publications and other qualifications issued by private bodies, which cannot be self-declared, must be provided in copy together with a self-declaration affidavit attesting their conformity to the original version, according to articles 19 and 19-bis of Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000.

FOREIGN APPLICANTS HOLDING A UNIVERSITY DEGREE ISSUED ABROAD

Foreign applicants holding a university degree issued abroad must fill in the online application and upload the following documents in PDF format (each file not exceeding 1 MB):

- certificate attesting the award of a 2nd level foreign degree needed to access a 2nd level Professional Master's Programme, including exams and marks, with a translation in Italian or English;
- certificate attesting the award of a 1st level foreign degree, including exams and marks, with a translation in Italian or English;
- signed Curriculum Vitae preferably in EU format, in English or Italian;
- additional qualifications, certifications, publications and work experiences, detailed in English or in Italian;
- two-sided coloured copy of a valid ID, with a clear photo.

If the foreign degree has already been declared equivalent to the Italian degree reported in art. 2 by another Italian University, the candidate will report the reference of the University and the number of Rector's decree of the declaration of equivalence.

Otherwise, if the foreign degree has not been considered equivalent, the Examination Board will deliberate on its equivalence, in compliance with the current legislation in Italy and in the Country where it was issued and with the international treaties or agreements concerning the recognition of qualifications for further studies, for the sole purpose of admission to the Professional Master's programme.

EU citizens can submit their replacement declarations according to art. 46, 47, 19 and 19-bis of Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000.

Non-EU citizens, legally resident in Italy, can provide the above-mentioned replacement declarations, only with reference to situations, personal qualities and facts which can be certified or attested by Italian public bodies.

Both the form and all the documents attached will be acquired by the University at the closing of the online enrolment procedure.

All applicants are admitted conditionally to the selection, and can be excluded in any moment, also after the admission tests, for lack of the requirements of this call.

The University will check the truthfulness of candidates' self-declarations/affidavits.

Without prejudice to criminal sanctions under the Penal Code and the related special laws (articles 75 and 76 of Italian Presidential Decree no. 445/2000), if the University administrative offices discover that the information declared by the applicant is mendacious or false, he/she will not be able to enrol.

Applicants should communicate any change of residence or other address used to apply.

The University administration declines all responsibilities in the case of loss of documents, caused by inaccurate information regarding the applicant's permanent or habitual address, the non-communication of a change of address, or postal errors which are not attributable to the University Administration's offices.

ART. 8 - ADMISSION PROCEDURE, COMMITTEE AND SELECTION

An Examination Board will be appointed by the Master's Council to select the candidates on the assessment of their Curriculum Vitae, qualifications, scientific publications and professional experience in the fields taught in the Master's Programme, and an interview.

THE INTERVIEW IS SCHEDULED ON 2ND DECEMBER 2019, AT 9 A.M. IN 'AULA ZEDDA', BLOCK E – EDUCATIONAL BRANCH OF MEDICINE, UNIVERSITY CAMPUS, SS 554 – CROSSROADS FOR SESTU, MONSERRATO, (CA).

Candidates should attend the interview at scheduled time and place bringing a valid ID.

Candidates unable to be interviewed at the scheduled location, for justifiable reasons, can be allowed to be interviewed in tele/videoconference on the same date of the interview in person, upon identity verification done by asking the candidate to show the same ID attached to the online application, in order to ensure the transparency and publicity of selection.

The applicant's request of tele/videoconference with the motivation should be sent together with the copy of an ID to the e-mail address of the contact person (ref. to art. 18) within three days before the



date of the interview. The Examination Board will decide at its sole discretion if accepts or not the candidate's request. Its decision will be communicated via e-mail to the candidate.

If the Examination Board will not express its decision, it will mean that the candidate's request has been rejected, and he/she should attend the interview in person.

The University of Cagliari declines any responsibility for any technical problem which might impede to give the interview.

If candidates are not present at the date and time indicated for the admission test or they don't answer at their account for the tele/videoconference interview, this will be considered as a waiver to the admission test.

ART. 9 - RANKING LIST

The Examination Board will draw up the ranking list, on the basis of the applicants' comparative evaluation, in accordance with the criteria set out for the admission to the 2nd level Professional Master's Programme, taking into consideration the total scores of each candidate. In case of candidates obtaining the same ranking position, the younger will prevail.

ART. 10 - INCOMPATIBILITY

The enrolment in a 2nd level Professional Master's Programme is incompatible with the enrolment in other undergraduate, PhD, specialization courses, professional master's or non-medical specialization schools at the University of Cagliari or other Italian and foreign universities.

ART. 11 - ENROLMENT

In order to enrol, successful candidates must first fill in the enrolment form available at the website <https://webstudenti.unica.it/esse3/Start.do>, uploading a recent passport-size photo in digital format (bitmap or jpeg) and a copy of a valid ID, **within five days starting from the day of the ranking list publication.**

The enrolment procedure will be completed when the PhD and Professional Master office of the University of Cagliari will have verified the completeness and accuracy of the application and the required documents, as well as the payment of the stamp duty (EUR 16.00) and of the first instalment of the tuition fee, within the deadline above.

ART. 12 - TUITION FEE

The tuition fee required to join the professional Master’s programme is EUR 4,000.00 + EUR 16.00 (stamp duty), to be paid in two instalments, following the instructions available at https://www.unica.it/unica/it/studenti_s02_ss01.page (*Istruzioni pagamento*), within the deadlines below:

1 st instalment	EUR 2,000,00 + EUR 16,00 (stamp duty), at the enrolment
2 nd instalment	EUR 2,000.00 within 14 th June 2019

The instalment plan for the tuition fee is intended to be a facilitation for the student, who undertakes to pay the total amount of EUR 4,000.00 even in the event of withdrawal or non-completeness of the programme.

ART. 13 - MANDATORY ATTENDANCE AND FINAL EXAMINATION

The Programme implies that candidates attend all courses as full-time students, for at least the 80% of the scheduled hours of the educational activities. At the end of the Programme, each candidate will defend a Master’s thesis, consisting of the following:

- introduction;
- materials and methods;



- debate and conclusions.

ART. 14 - FINAL DEGREE

The Rector of the University of Cagliari will award the 2nd level Professional Master's in **CLINICAL AND SURGICAL ENDODONTICS** to participants completing the activities scheduled in the programme and a final examination.

ART. 15 - MASTER'S AUTHORITIES AND ORGANIZATION OF ACTIVITIES

The Director and the Organizational Technical and Scientific Committee are Master's authorities. The Organizational Technical and Scientific Committee, chaired by the Director, coordinates the educational activities. The Director represents the educational structure, convenes the Organizational Technical and Scientific Committee and control the proper functioning of the course, takes the management responsibility, and, at its conclusion, submits a report on the activities to the Director of the Department.

The Organizational Technical and Scientific Committee includes the Director of the Professional Master's Programme, and the following members: Prof. Pietro Giorgio Calò, Prof. Giuseppe Mercurio and Dr. Claudia Dettori.
