Gramsci in South Africa

Professor Vally will give a lecture on the resonance of Gramsci's praxis for South African activists, particularly the concepts of hegemony and ideological consent. Gramsci's views on the 'war of position', 'war of manœuvre', the role of intellectuals and the connections between the state and civil society was influential amongst South African activists in the 80s. In the post-apartheid period, particularly after the Marikana massacre of mineworkers in 2012, discussion around hegemony, domination/repression and ideological consent exercised by the ruling class is once again resurgent. Twenty-three years after the first democratic election in South Africa, the talk will consider the continued relevance of Gramscian notions for the workers' movement.
